Grade 5 Scripture Incentive Program

October 21 -

Romans 10:9: "Say with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord.' Believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead. Then you will be saved."

October 28 -

John 1:12: "Some people did accept him and did believe in his name. He gave them the right to become children of God."

November 4 -

John 14:6: "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"

November 11 -

Galatians 2:20: "I have been crucified with Christ. I don't live any longer, but Christ lives in me. Now I live my life in my body by faith in the Son of God. He loved me and gave himself for me."

November 18 -

1 Timothy 4:12: "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young. Set an example for the believers in what you say and in how you live. Also set an example in how you love and in what you believe. Show the believers how to be pure."

November 25 -

Ephesians 5:20: "Always give thanks to God the Father for everything. Give thanks to him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

December 2 -

1 Peter 3:15: "But make sure that in your hearts you honor Christ as Lord. Always be ready to give an answer to anyone who asks you about the hope you have. Be ready to give the reason for it. But do it gently and with respect."

December 9 -

John 3:16: "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life."

December 16 -

Luke 2:9-10: "An angel of the Lord appeared to them. And the glory of the Lord shone around them. They were terrified. But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news. It will bring great joy for all the people.'"

December 23 -

Luke 2:11-12: "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you. He is the Messiah, the Lord. Here is how you will know I am telling you the truth. You will find a baby wrapped in strips of cloth and lying in a manger."

December 30 -

Isaiah 43:19a: "I am about to do something new. It is beginning to happen even now."
